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On Board with Gary



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WATCH-OUT FOR BROKEN PIPES!

Recently a VDL irrigation pipe broke; the leaking water caused a good size leak in our expenses. The estimate added cost to our water bill is over \$2000. and Chelan Reclamation District won't give us a reprieve for that leak. If you see a unexplainable puddle of water on the communities' lawns or landscaping, please notify Jose who is our landscaper or Gary Collins who is the chairman of the Buildings and Grounds Committee.

Each owner should periodically check their water meter to ensure their pipes are not leaking. If you turn-off all the water in you abode and the meter is running, you may have a broken or leaking pipe. The loss of water from leaking or broken pipes may equate to a large water bill, so shut-off the water and get it repaired.

WHEN ARE BOARD MINUTES PUBLISHED?

The Secretary compiles the minutes for the Board meeting and provides the Board with a draft copy. The Board reviews the minutes according to a motion and votes whether to reject, revise or approve the minutes. Board approves the minutes, the minutes are distributed to the HOA and added to the website. During the next Board meeting, the Board will consider a resolution to review and vote on a draft copy of the minutes within two weeks of the Board meeting. This special vote would occur by email.
