Yardsale/Fundraiser:

The almost-annual Vista Del Lago community yard sale and fundraiser will be held on Saturday, July 14th, from 8:00am until noon (longer if we still have good stuff to sell). The sale is scheduled to be announced on KOZI and the Second Cup show throughout the week and on Saturday. In addition, the yard sale will appear on the KOZI website, which means we should have a good turn out.

This year's proceeds from donated sale items will go towards buying new pool furniture. We still need to replace some of the old lounge chairs and need to buy additional tables and chairs. We would also like to buy a few side tables for holding snacks and beverages by the lounge chairs. This will most likely be a work in progress, as far as getting all the items we need, but we already have a great head start.....see the next headline for more info.

If you would like to participate in the community yard sale, but do not want to donate all of your precious items because they have some significant value, you will be allowed to bring your items and sell them in a separate area next to the donated items. You will be asked to donate a percentage of your profits to the fundraiser at the end of the sale.
