First, a few reminders from the Board.....

- Minor children, even when accompanied by an owner, are not allowed to use the clubhouse facilities, which include playing billiards.
- Any and all modifications of any sort done to an owners' property needs to be approved by the Architecture Committee.
- Dennis spent a fair amount of time hosing off the pool deck last week because someone threw several handfuls of rocks onto the deck and into the pool. A fair guess is that someone's guest children are responsible for this, thus the need for all children to be accompanied while off the owner's property.
- Please do not park your vehicle or allow your guests to park their vehicles on other people's lots, even the undeveloped lots, unless you have received permission from the owner to do so. If you have received permission, it would be a good practice to notify a Board member that you have permission, or better yet,

have the owner notify (via email) a Board member that they have granted permission.

- The little **green turtles** are a great reminder that the speed limit is **10 MPH**. Please be sure you are adhering to the speed limit at all times, especially when traveling downhill on the back stretch.
- Boats are only allowed to be parked for maintenance purposes for 24 hours.
- Children must be escorted by an adult when they are off an owner's property. Kids are not allowed to ride their bicycles, skateboard, roller skate, etc around the park unless they are accompanied by an adult.

Speaking of food, a restaurant review.....

A group of us went to Tin Lilly's in downtown Chelan (on Woodin Ave, just across from the pool store). The place starts to fill up at 6:00pm and is generally full by 6:30 on Saturdays, so if you have a large party, plan on arriving for an early dinner about 5:45, because no reservations are accepted.

We found the menu to be expansive, with many choices from burgers, to ribs, salads, pasta, fish and a large assortment of appetizers. They have a great happy hour and fun bar area, with several large screen televisions, playing a variety of sporting events.

They have inside and outside seating and we found the back patio to be quite comfortable. Their prices are very reasonable, with burgers in the \$8.50 range, a full rack of ribs \$24, and salads from \$4-\$14. You get plenty of food and I can vouch for the chocolate cake, even though Anna only let me have 2 bites of hers!
