## Reminder on a few very important rules.....

Children are not allowed in the pool after 3:00, regardless of who is in the pool. The family swim time is 10:00am-3:00pm. This is a rule we must all abide by and it is not fair for some people to abide by it and others to disregard the rule.

In addition, the RV and Boat Parking is one space per lot owned. That means, if you own one lot, you can park one boat or RV item on the lot. If you are not in compliance, please do so immediately.

The parking in front of the clubhouse is for guests and temporary overflow parking, not storage.

These are all rules that everyone must adhere to. We are setting precedence for the future. If the rules are not followed now, they will be very difficult to enforce in the years to come when the park gets more crowded.
